#### ORDINANCE NO. 1

### REGULATIONS FOR OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES ON TOWN HIGHWAYS

It is hereby resolved and enacted that an Ordinance, to be known as Ordinance No. 1, of the Town of Piercefield, regulating the use and operation of snowmobiles within the limits of the Town of Piercefield, as authorized by Article 8 of the conservation law of the State of New York, in the following manner:

# OPERATION ON TOWN HIGHWAYS

Travel on the shoulder or inside bank of all town roads and town streets will be permitted only for the specific purpose of traveling to and from rural snowmobile trails.

### COMPLIANCE WITH NEW YORK STATE SNOWMOBILE REGULATIONS

Every snowmobile operated on a town highway must be in compliance with the regulations set forth in Article 8 of the Conservation Law and must also be operated in accord with any supplementary Rules and Regulations implementing the snowmobile law issued by the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation, Division of Marine and Recreational Vehicles.

# **ENFORCEMENT**

Every law enforcement officer of the State of New York, County of St. Lawrence, and the Town of Piercefield, shall enforce the provisions of the Ordinance.

### **PENALTY**

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a violation and shall be punished by a fine of not les than five dollars (\$5.00) and not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

This Ordinance shall take effect on February 26, 1972.
